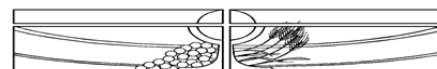
**2018 DISASTERS NATIONAL COLLECTION**  
**OCTOBER 28, 2018**

The traditional storm season has had two severe hurricanes (Florence and Michael). Thousands of homes, businesses and churches have been severely damaged or destroyed. Catholic parishes throughout our country are asking to take up a special one-time collection for 2018 Disasters in October. The funds collected in this special appeal for 2018 Disasters will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter, and medical care and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts, and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church. Funds will be used in response to Hurricanes Florence and Michael and any other natural disasters that occur this year (now including the Earthquake and Tsunami in Indonesia). Our parish will have a special collection on the weekend of October 27-28<sup>th</sup>.
