We are planning to leave Indianapolis on Saturday night after the Closing Mass. We will travel all night arriving in Williamstown by 2:00pm, Sunday, November 19<sup>th</sup>.

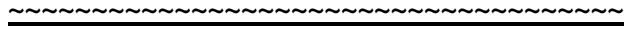

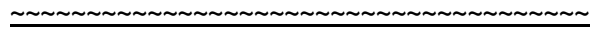
