**LENTEN ACTION FOR DREAMERS:
CONGRESSIONAL CALL-IN CAMPAIGN**

On Monday, February 26, the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops is asking all of us to call our Senators and Representatives to urge them to pass legislation that protects Dreamers, young people without immigration status who were brought to the United States by their parents. Dreamers are our immigrant sisters and brothers. In our diocese, Bishop Dennis Sullivan asks that you contact Senators Booker and Menendez, as well as Representatives Lo Biondo and Norcross and ask them to support a bipartisan, common-sense, and humane solution for Dreamers; to protect Dreamers from deportation and provide them with a path to citizenship; and to reject proposals that undermine family immigration or protections for unaccompanied children. **REPORT SEXUAL ABUSE**

An independent, toll-free number has been established by the Diocese of Camden to help callers report cases of sexual abuse by priests, deacons, religious, employees and/or volunteers.
