UNITED UNDER ONE SHEPHERD

Today, the Catholic Church throughout the world celebrates Good Shepherd Sunday. The focus of the gospel is Jesus' calling himself the Good Shepherd, that his father has entrusted all of us to Him.

The Church reminds us every time we celebrate the Mass that we have shepherds under Christ the Good Shepherd. During the Eucharistic prayer we pray for church members, living and dead.

We ask God to remember his church "spread through the world". Then we recall the name of the pope and bishop for the diocese. We do this as an expression and sign of our unity as a church that is called to be one, holy, catholic and apostolic. We pray makes this prayer in union with all God's people throughout history who have been called by the voice of the shepherd.

Our unity is not some abstract connection or idea but it is marked by specific prisms recognized as shepherds for the people of God. This is why we remember by name Pope Francis, Bishop Dennis Sullivan, then in general all the clergy.
