MSGR. JAMES TRACY

Msgr. James R. Tracy was a priest for the Diocese of Camden for over 64 years. Msgr. Tracy died on April 23rd at the age of 88 years: Msgr. Tracy and his family lived in Pennsauken, he attended St. Cecilia School, graduating in 1949 and received the Sacrament of Confirmation here as well. Msgr. Tracy was ordained in Rome in 1960. He had made sure that one of his first Masses when he returned to the U.S. was at St. Cecilia's with his family and friends. Msgr. Tracy would always ask me how the "great people of Pennsauken were doing." May he rest in peace.



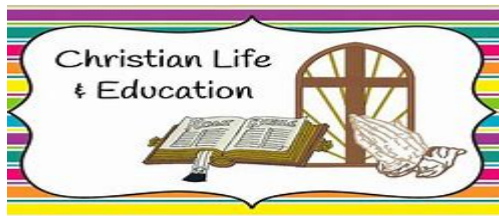
MOTHER'S DAY
